Veterans Fly Rod Making Classes

Platte Rivers Veterans Fly Fishing (PRVFF), which is supported by RMFTU, will be starting their annual fly rod building classes in January. These are for military veterans who want to make a fly rod. To participate, the veteran should register on the Platte Rivers Website and then contact Dave Morse. Rod kits in #4 thru #7 weight, materials, and instruction are free for veterans who are making their first rod with PRVFF.

Classes will be held on Saturday mornings from January through April in Fort Collins, Loveland, and Greeley, and at two Wyoming locations. The Fort Collins classes will be held from 9-noon at the Peace with Christ Lutheran Church, 1412 W Swallow St. in Ft Collins, which is just west of Rocky Mountain Highschool. It takes about 8 classes to complete a rod. Dave Morse can put you in touch with area leads. Civilian and veteran mentors who have built a rod in the past are needed and welcome.
