## **Stream Monitoring Workshop Success**



RMFTU held our Stream Monitoring Workshop on June 10. The presenters were Chris Carroll of the Forest Service, Cory Dick of the Coalition for the Poudre River Watershed, and Phil Wright of Rocky Mountain Flycasters. Roger Slocomb demonstrated the new Mayfly Water Quality Monitoring Station which can continuously upload real time data to the internet from multiple water quality sensors.

The Workshop was well attended and there were many who were new to the RMFTU Stream Monitoring Project. Our team will be conducting site visits this summer and we plan to hold a field day to train new volunteers. Our primary stream temperature data retrieval will begin in the Fall.

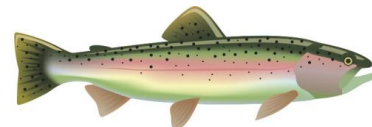

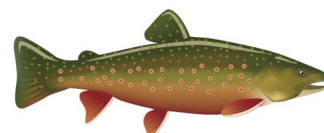
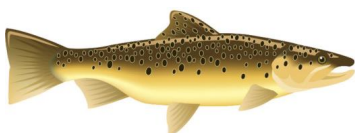
